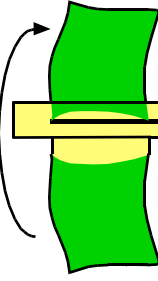


Lifeguard Stand

To assemble:

- Cut the building from this sheet with scissors. Cut slits carefully with hobby knife.
- Fold and gently crease tabs, corners of building, roof panels and bottom flaps.
- Slip tabs into slots. Save bottom flaps until last.
- Fold bottom flaps under in numerical order. Flap 4 is last and should tuck under Flap 1 to hold them all in place. Use glue or tape for permanent assembly.

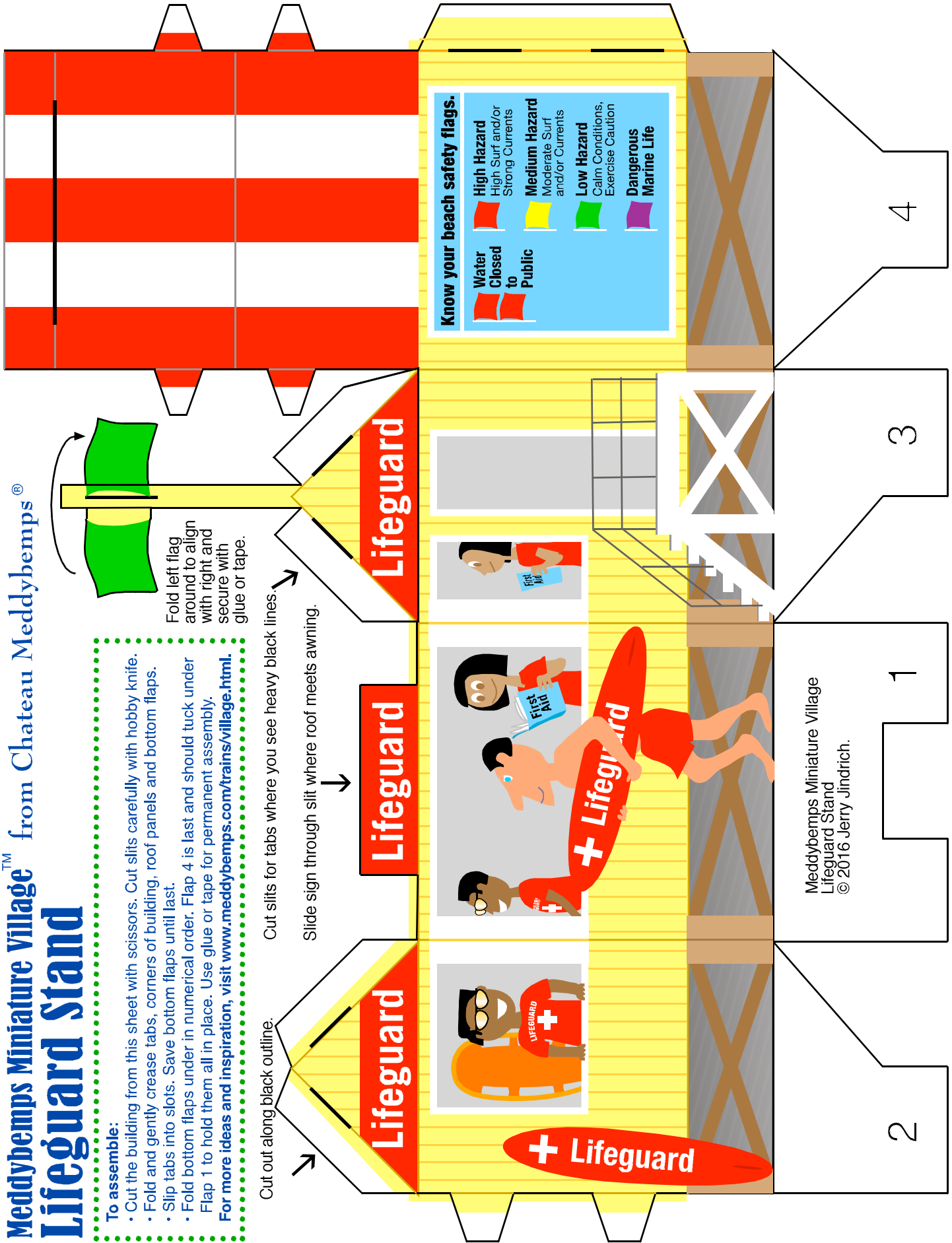


Fold left flag around to align with right and secure with glue or tape.

Cut out along black outline.

Cut slits for tabs where you see heavy black lines.

Slide sign through slit where roof meets awning.
